This free course can be embedded to enrich your existing teaching and learning and introduce some of the core themes to hold safe and ethical practice.

The ten-hour course is free to access for CPCAB centres and candidates. It gives candidates studying the Diploma in Therapeutic Counselling Level 4 (TC-L4) and higher levels some basic training to support their development in working safely and ethically while using online technology and/or the telephone during this challenging time.

The introductory course offers ten hours of guided tuition, self-directed learning – all online, accessed via a secure portal. The course is self-directed learning via the online lectures and resources; this means that students can work at their own pace and complete the course without any external time pressure.

A completion certificate will be issued to evidence course completion.
